

# 2007 Snowflake

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Celtic Twisted Ring Snowflake –

Two shuttles wound CTM with any thread

Tat a split ring ( 6 vlp 6 / give the core thread a half twist so your wrapped stitches are on core that crosses from the other side of the ring. Continue with the 2nd side of the split ring, 6 Thrown off ring ( 4 - 2 - 1 lp 1 - 2 - 4 ) 6 )

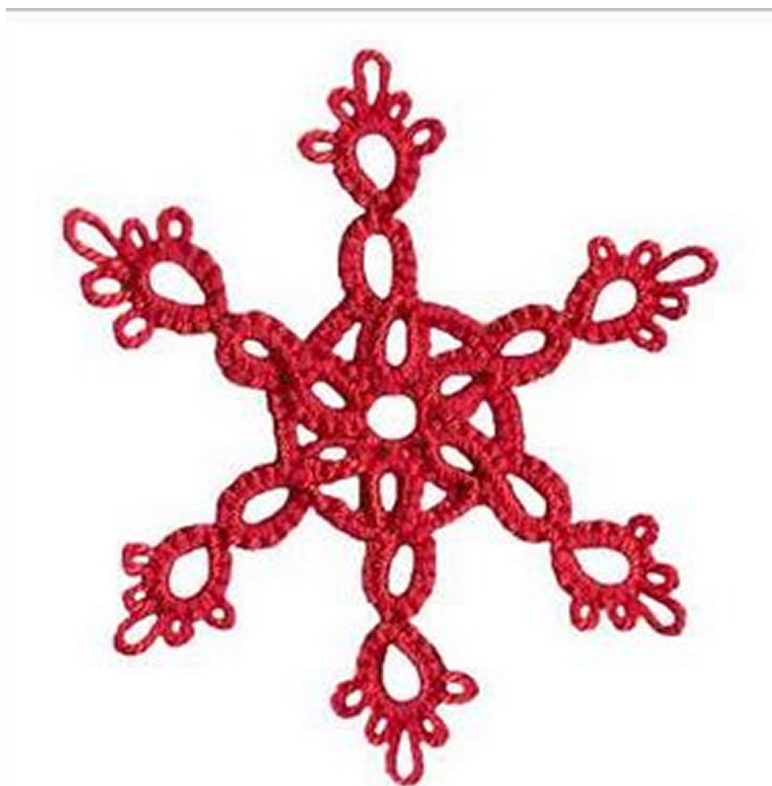
Close this ring carefully (and it should probably not be tatted with delicate thread). The thread will close the ring and it will be in the shape of a figure 8.

Chain 4

Tat another twisted ring and join to the picot of the first ring as shown in the diagram below.

Repeat so you have 6 twisted rings all joined at that one picot, chains between, and rings thrown off.

The last one joins to the previous and to the first ring.



The twisted ring is shown with a yellow background in the diagram above.

Shuttle 1 is shown in black, and shuttle 2 is shown in gray.
