

TATTET RAINBOW

Materials:

Size 20 cotton in purple, indigo, blue, green, yellow, orange and red.
 2 shuttles
 Flexible PVA craft glue.

Method: Please note all picots are very small picots.

Wind 38 inches of purple thread evenly between 2 shuttles.

Ch 1 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 SLT, TWO

Ch - 4 ↓ - 4 ↓ - 4 ↓ - 4 ↓ - 4 ↓ - 4 ↓ - 4 ↓ - 1, tie & cut ends close, dab knot with glue. TWO

Wind 38 inches of indigo thread evenly between 2 shuttles and ± to 1st vsp.

Ch - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ SLT, TWO

Ch - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 5 ↓ - 1, tie & cut ends close, dab knot with glue. TWO

Wind 46 inches of blue thread evenly between 2 shuttles and ± to 1st vsp.

Ch - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ SLT, TWO

Ch - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 6 ↓ - 1, tie & cut ends close, dab knot with glue. TWO

Wind 56 inches of green thread evenly between 2 shuttles and ± to 1st vsp.

Wind 66 inches of yellow thread evenly between 2 shuttles and ± to 1st vsp.

Ch - 8 ↓ - 8 ↓ - 8 ↓ - 8 ↓ - 8 ↓ - 8 ↓ - 8 ↓ - 1, tie & cut ends close, dab knot with glue. TWO

Wind 70 inches of orange thread evenly between 2 shuttles and ± to 1st vsp.

Ch - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ SLT, TWO

Ch - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 9 ↓ - 1, tie & cut ends close, dab knot with glue. TWO

Wind 76 inches of red thread evenly between 2 shuttles and ± to 1st vsp.

Ch - 10 ↓ - 10 ↓ - 10 ↓ - 10 ↓ - 10 ↓ - 10 ↓ - 10 ↓ - 10 ↓ SLT, TWO

Ch 10 ↓ 10 ↓ 10 ↓ 10 ↓ 10 ↓ 10 ↓ 10 ↓ 10 ↓, tie & cut ends close, dab knot with glue.



Abbreviations and instructions

Ch chain

- very small picot

↓ join to very small picot on previous row

± lock join

SLT Shoe lace trick, work 1st half of ds without flipping, this changes shuttles

TWO turn work over like turning the pages of a book
