

TATTED ORNAMENT

R10±10, RW, C5-2-2-5, RW.* Repeat between *'s for 6 rings and 6 chains, joining last chain to base of first ring. This completes a wheel.

C6, RW, R5+ (to p of last chain of wheel)5-10, RW, @C6±6-6-6-6 (5 p's), RW. SS.@

R10-10, RW; C5-2-2-5, R10+10, RW; C5+ (to p of adjacent R)2-2-5, RW. Repeat between *'s 4 times, joining last chain to base of first ring of this wheel. RW. SS. Repeat between @ but do not join first p. RW. On last repeat join first p of chain to corresponding picot of first chain.

R10+ (to 1st p of next-to-last chain of wheel)5-5, RW, C6, SS. On last repeat join last p of ring to corresponding p of adjacent chain.

R10-10, RW, C5 + (to free p at end of adjacent ring)2-2-5, RW. Repeat between *'s for a total of 6 rings and chains in this wheel, joining last chain to base of first ring. RW. SS.

C6, RW, R5+ (to 1st p of adjoining chain)5-10, RW. Repeat between @'s and continue for desired length.

8 wheels (4 up, 4 down) cover a tear-shaped glass ornament in #20 thread.

8 wheels (4 up, 4 down) cover a glass ball in #30 thread.

TOP AND BOTTOM STOPPERS: [R5±5-5-5, RW, C5-2-2-5, RW]. Repeat between []'s for a total of 12 rings and 12 chains.
