

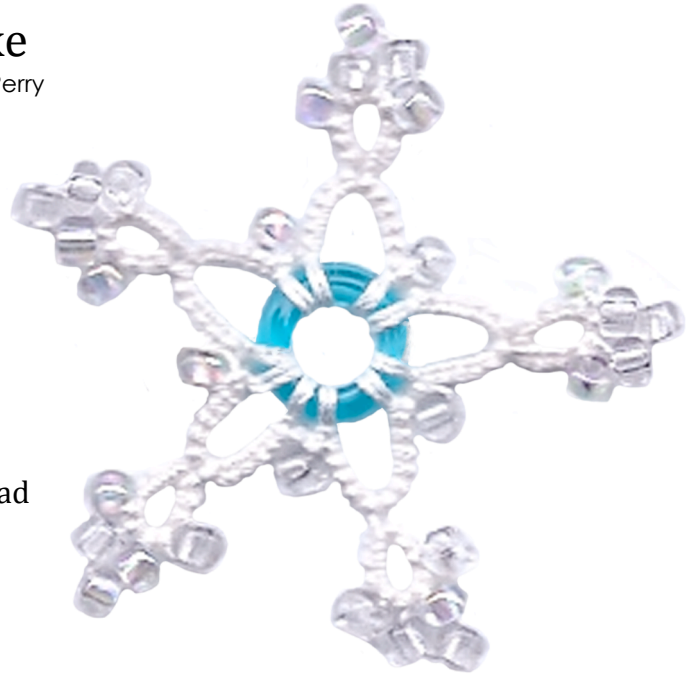
Five Point Beaded Snowflake

This shuttle and ball CTM snowflake is tatted on a small donut bead.

5 seed beads on the ball thread
25 seed beads on the shuttle

Begin by holding the thread between the ball and shuttle. This will make a loop in the thread. Insert this loop through the middle of the donut bead, then put the bead through the loop. This will make a larks head knot on the bead. It looks like a DS around the bead.



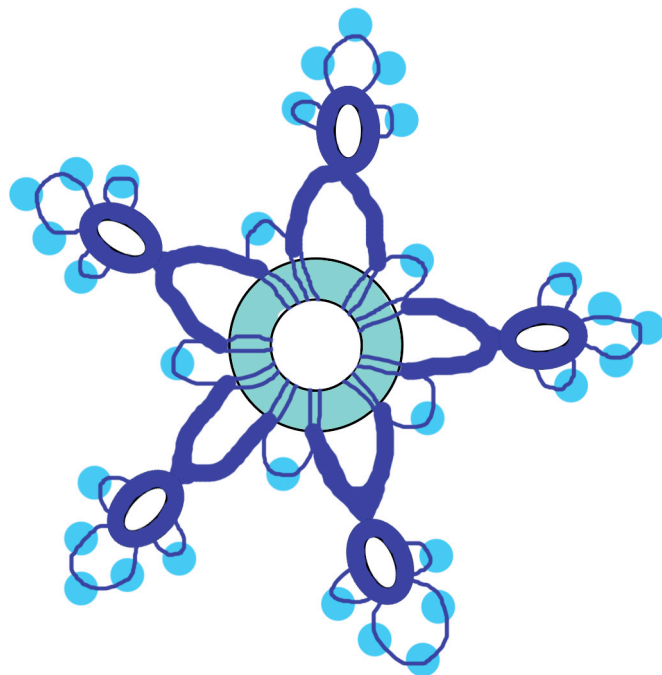
Chain 6 turn
Ring (3 B 1 BBB 1 B 3) turn
Chain 6

Join to the donut bead using the split chain technique also called Bridging or Dora Young's Knotless method. There is an easy tutorial by Marie Smith available online as well as more information about the split chain here:

Chain 1 B 1

Join to the donut bead again then repeat around until there are five rings with beads and five beads between the chains. Tie the ends at the beginning, then hide the ends and cut close to the work.
