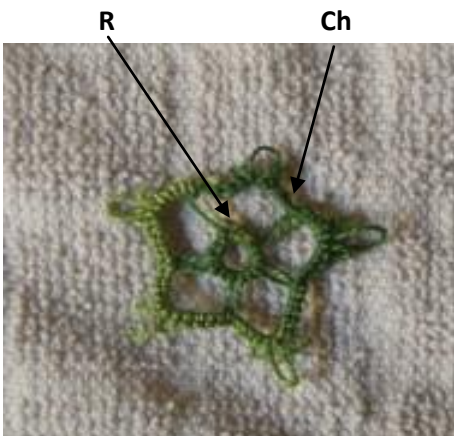

ADDING MORE CLUNIES.- Example



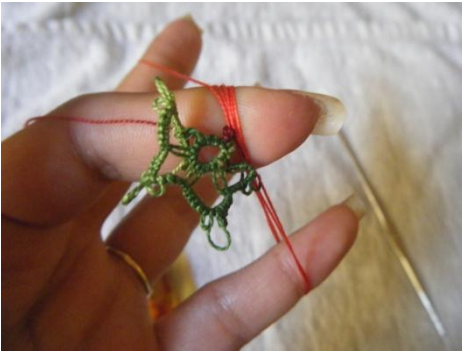
Picture # 1

1. Using one shuttle in green
2. R [{3--} 4 times] 3
3. CTM: mock picot to get to next round.
4. Add second shuttle with red.
5. Ch [{5-1—1-5+ Lj to next free picot} 4 times]
6. Ch 5-1—1-5+ Lj to first picot.
7. Close and cut.

8. Use two different red tones or your preferred color.
9. Start the cluny in any of the picots from the first row
10. Tie them with a knot.

11. Star the frame to make the cluny. See the Double Cluny Instructions from Carmin.



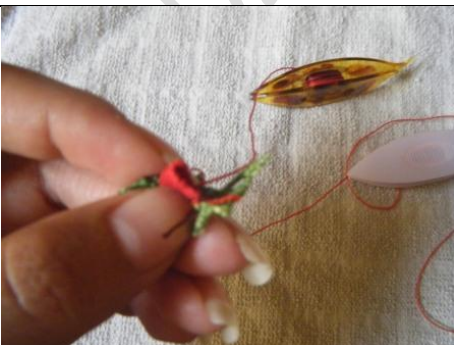

12. Follow all the instructions.



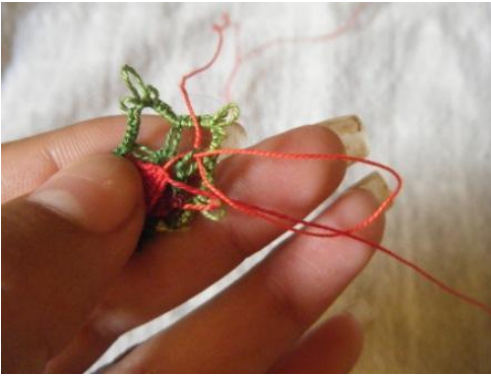

13. Until it is finished.



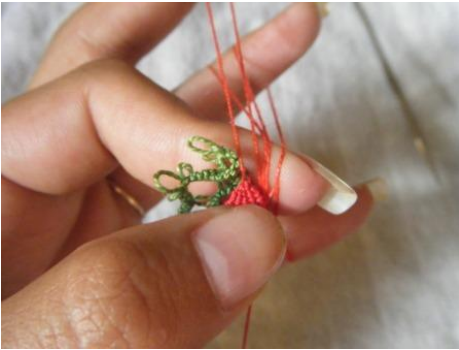

14. Fold the cluny to the right.



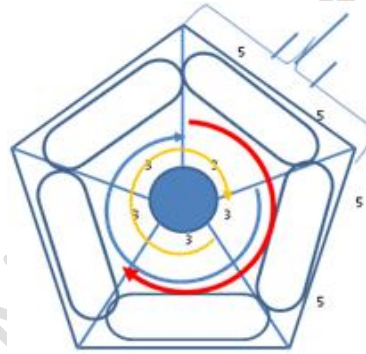

15. Skip 2 picots and anchor it with a Lj piont in the next one.

18. Small clunies use 3 threads in the frame.
