Cluny Towel Edging by Dagmar Pezzuto

Method: The two rows of cluny tallies and split rings are tatted first and the decorative row of chains is added last. There is an inner row which is attached to the towel and an outer row of split rings and cluny tallies. Begin with the outer row on the right side. Locate the start of the row on what becomes the far right side of the edging. Begin with a split ring.

*Split Ring 4 - 1 - 1 - 4 / 4 - 1 - (long picot which will join across the edging to the inner row) 1 - 4

Cluny: Make a cluny with 13 round trip passes. Repeat from * for the width desired. End with a split ring.



Close split ring but do not reverse work.

CH 8 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 8 dnrw.

Rotate the edging so you are going back the opposite direction.

*Split Ring 4 - 1 - 1 - 4 / 4 - 1 + 1 - 4

Cluny: Make a cluny with 13 complete round trip passes.

Repeat from * . End with a split ring.

Close split ring but do not reverse work.

CH 8 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 8 dnrw. Shuttle lock join to the base of the starter split ring. Rotate the edging to work back the opposite direction.

CH 5 - 1 - 1 - 5 + (join to middle picot on the same split ring) and continue to chain CH 8 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 8 + (join to middle picot on the next split ring) continue to the end and join the last short chain to the chase of the end split ring on the outer row.
