

# 3 Hearts in My Lanyards

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## Skill Level

Advanced Beginner

## Supplies Needed

2 shuttles  
Thread size 10 or 20  
11mm beads  
Floss threader  
2 large jump rings  
2 lanyard hooks or  
2 jumbo claw clasps



## \*Pink Heart Lanyard size 40 thread used

Shuttle 1 31 beads, shuttle 2 124 beads

**SR = seta, 3B, setb, 10ds/10ds use this pattern for all 3 lanyards**

Make 33 or less hearts depending on the desired length and end off. Attach your thread to the 1<sup>st</sup> heart continue w/pattern.

## Diamond Load shuttle w/93 beads size 10 thread used

SR = 3 ds — 3ds/3ds -3ds

R = 3ds JPPR, 3ds — 3ds — 3ds, CLR, RW, SS

R=3ds JPPR, 3ds—3ds - 3ds

CLR, RW, SS

SR = 3ds, JPPR 3ds/3ds, JPPR 3ds, CLR

\* pattern for 15 inches or desired length, ending with the diamond pattern, cut, tie and hide ends.

+ To 1<sup>st</sup> heart made where you began. Start with the diamond

## Flower load shuttle w/93 beads, size 10 thread used

SR = 1ds -2ds — 2ds -1ds/1ds - 2ds — 2ds - 1ds, CLR you can make the picots all the same length or different lengths.

\*pattern for 15 inches or desired length, ending w/heart.

+ To 1<sup>st</sup> flower made and continue to the same length as the 1<sup>st</sup> side.

Add a jump ring to the last element made and a jumbo claw clasp or lanyard clip

3B	Three beads
-	Picot

Shuttle 1	Core shuttle
CLR	Close Ring
RW	Reverse Work
SS	Switch Shuttles
Seta	Three 1 <sup>st</sup> half of DS
Setb	Three 2 <sup>nd</sup> half of DS
JPPR	+ to picot of previous ring
+	Join
