

**Wash. DC Cherry Blossom

Using one shuttle wound with dark pink #20 thread, begin the outer ring:

R: 7 - 13 - 4 + (join to previous picot)13 - 7 clr dnrw

\*R: 4 clr dnrw

R: 7 + (join to last picot on previous large ring) 13 - 4 + (join to previous picot)13 - 7 clr dnrw

Repeat from \* three more times attaching the last picot to the first picot on the first ring.

When tating the small inner ring, --- indicates a picot long enough to cut and tie a knot at the end of the thread; - indicates a short picot.

Using one shuttle wound with light pink #20 thread, begin the inner ring:

R: \*1 - 1 (join core thread to a very small ring on the Outer Ring) --- \*  
Repeat 4 more times clr

Cut long picot threads. Tie a knot at the end of the long picot threads (if you choose), or trim the threads to look like flower stamen.

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
