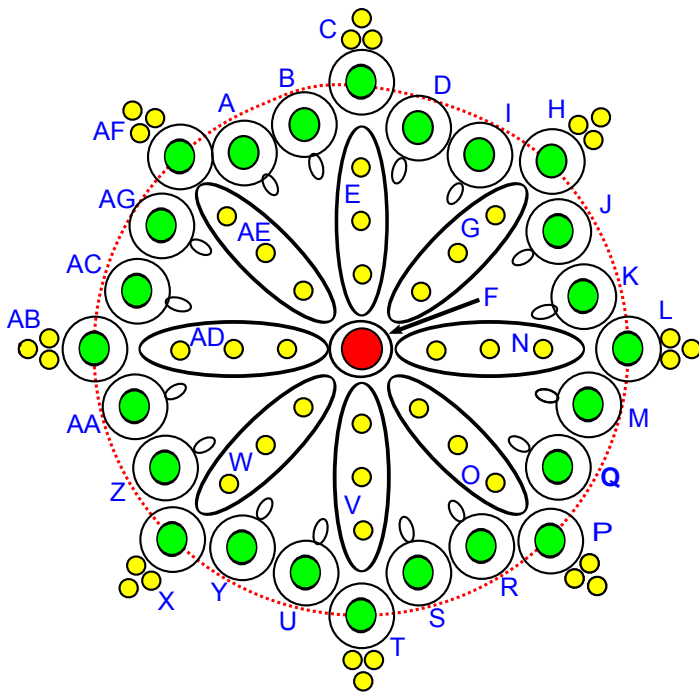


Instructions for Dagmar Pezzuto's Beaded Cluny Necklace Medallion Without Hanging Cluny Leaves



Symbols:

- Seed bead
- #4 bead
- #8 bead
- ⋯⋯⋯ Used to construct diagram, now I don't know how to get rid of it....

Abbreviations:

- R = Ring
- SR = Split Ring

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Cluny G: + <next picot on R F> (20 Passes) with 1 seed bead each in passes 5, 10, 15 (3 beads total)

SR H: 5 <place #4 bead on ring thread and secure with clip, safety pin, or paper clip>

R I: 5 + <tip of previous Cluny> 5 = <pick up bead loop> 5 + <previous outer R, (R D, first time thru)> 5, close
5 <3 seed beads> <place #4 bead on the other shuttle thread at the base of this loop, pick up this bead's loop> 5 / - 5 close

SR J: 5 <place #4 bead on the other shuttle thread at the base of this loop and secure with clip, safety pin, or paper clip> / 5 + <picot at base of previous ring> 5 <pick up bead loop> = 5, close

SR K: 5 <place #4 bead on other shuttle thread and secure with clip, safety pin, or paper clip> / 5 = 5 <pick up bead loop> 5, close

SR L: 5 <3 seed beads> <place #4 bead on the ring thread and secure with clip, safety pin, or paper clip> 5 <place #4 bead on ring thread and secure with clip, safety pin, or paper clip>

R M: 5 - 5 = <pick up last bead loop> 5 - 5, close
5 + <last picot previous R, (R M first time thru)> / 5 + <picot on previous SR, (SR K first time thru)> <pick up first bead's loop, close

Cluny N: (20 Passes) with 1 seed bead each in passes 5, 10, 15 (3 beads total), + <next picot on R F>

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Notes:

- means vsp, = means a picot which is for "show"

Most beads are added as tating progresses. Jane Eboral's tutorials show how this is done. See:

Prestringing seed beads for Cluny leaves is recommended.

Tatters may prestring other beads as desired.

Instructions developed using:

#10 or #20 thread

bead denoted as seed bead is 2.5 mm (4 beads/cm)

bead denoted as #4 is a 4 or 5 mm bead

bead denoted as #8 is a 8 mm bead

Two shuttles are needed. Shuttle threads must be joined at the start. The work is never turned.

SR A: 5 - 5 <place #4 bead on other shuttle thread and pick up bead loop> / 5 = 5, close

SR B: repeat instructions for SR A

R C: 5 + <SR B> 5 <3 seed beads> <place #4 bead on other shuttle thread and pick up this bead's loop> 5 <place #4 bead on ring thread and secure with clip, safety pin, or paper clip>

R D: 5 - 5 <pick up bead loop> = 5 - 5, close

5 + <R D> close

Cluny E: (20 Passes) with 1 seed bead each in passes 5, 10, 15 (3 beads total)

R F: 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 <place #8 bead on other shuttle thread and pick up this bead's loop> - 1 - 1 - 1 - 1, close

repeat * to * twice for Cluny O thru Cluny AD

repeat Cluny G for Cluny AE

R AF: 5 <place #4 bead on ring thread and secure with clip, safety pin, or paper clip>

R AG: 5 + <tip of Cluny AE> 5 = <pick up bead loop> 5 + <R AC> 5, close

5 <3 seed beads> <place #4 bead on the other shuttle thread at the base of this loop, pick up this bead's loop> 5 + <R A> 5, close

Join shuttle threads to secure last #4 bead
