Begin chain with starter picot

CH 8 - 8 dnrw

SH1 R 6 - 6 clr rw; SH2 R 6 - 6 clr rw

CH 8 - 8 dnrw

SH1 R 6 - 6 clr rw; SH2 R 6 - 6 clr rw

CH 8 - 8

Reposition work for onion ring which is surrounded by chain with floating rings

* inner ring 12 - 12 clr rw

outer ring 17 + vsp 17 vsp clr dnrw rotate 90degrees

CH 8 (floating ring 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 clr dnrw)

CH 7 (floating ring 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 clr dnrw)

CH 8 (floating ring 5 - 5 - 5 - 5 clr dnrw)

CH 7 (floating ring 4 - 4 + join to starter

picot 4 - 4 clr dnrw)

CH 8 (floating ring 4 + join to next small ring 4 - 4 - 4 clr dnrw)

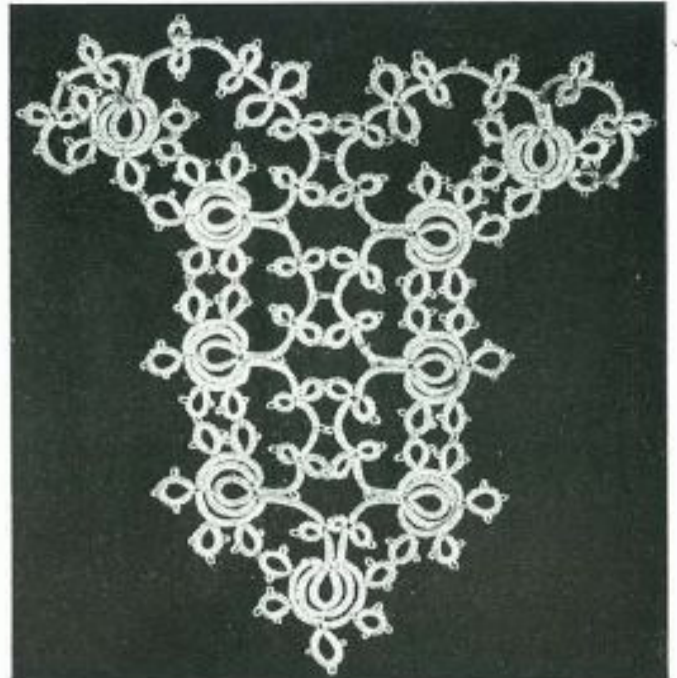

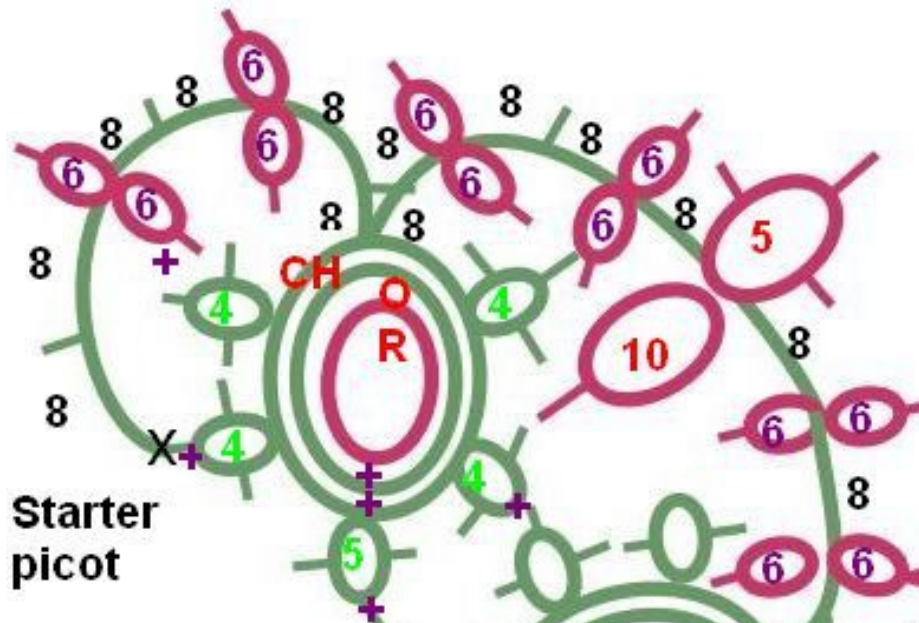

There were spots where the directions fit not match the lace so I went with what I saw not what I read.

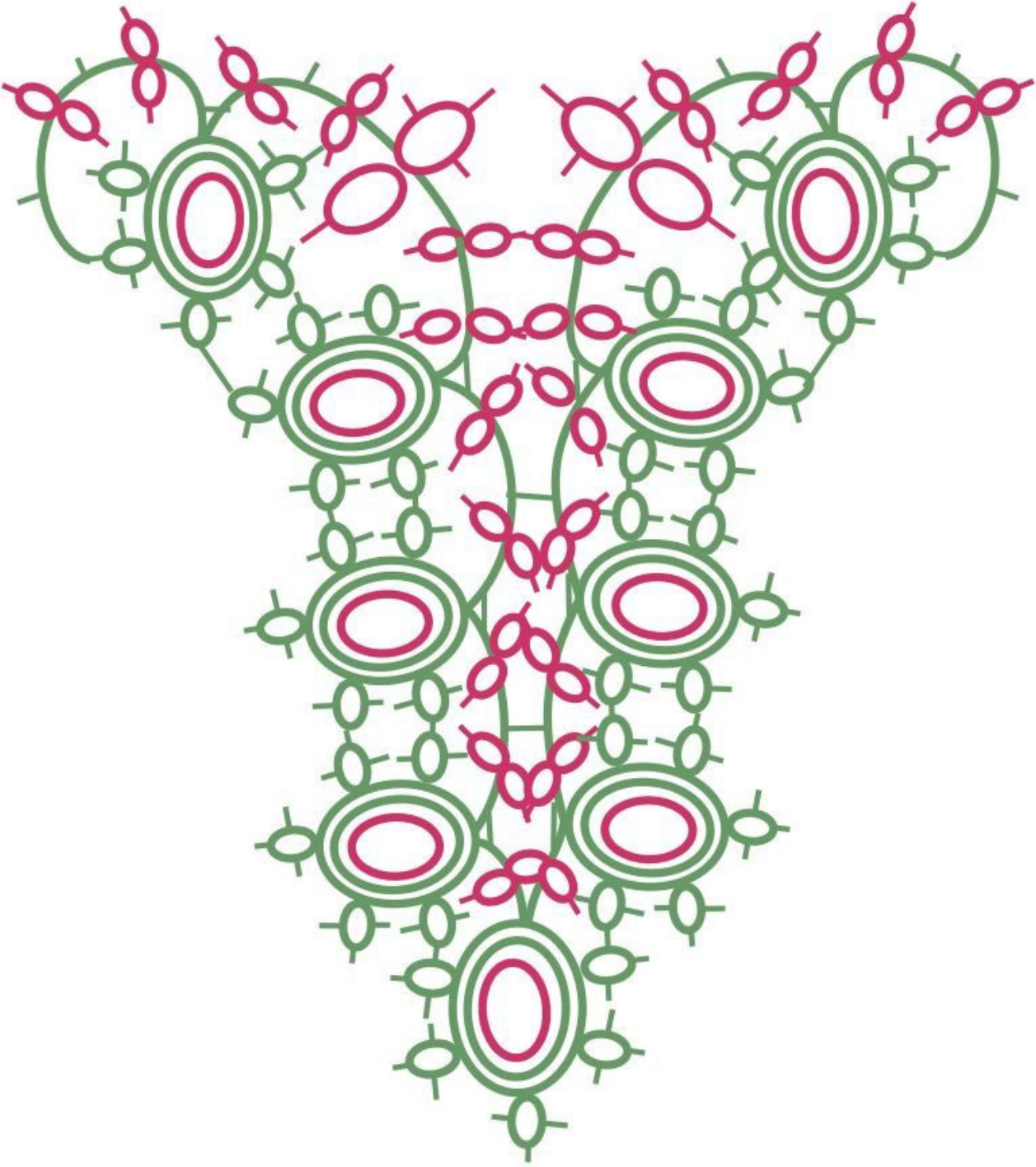
