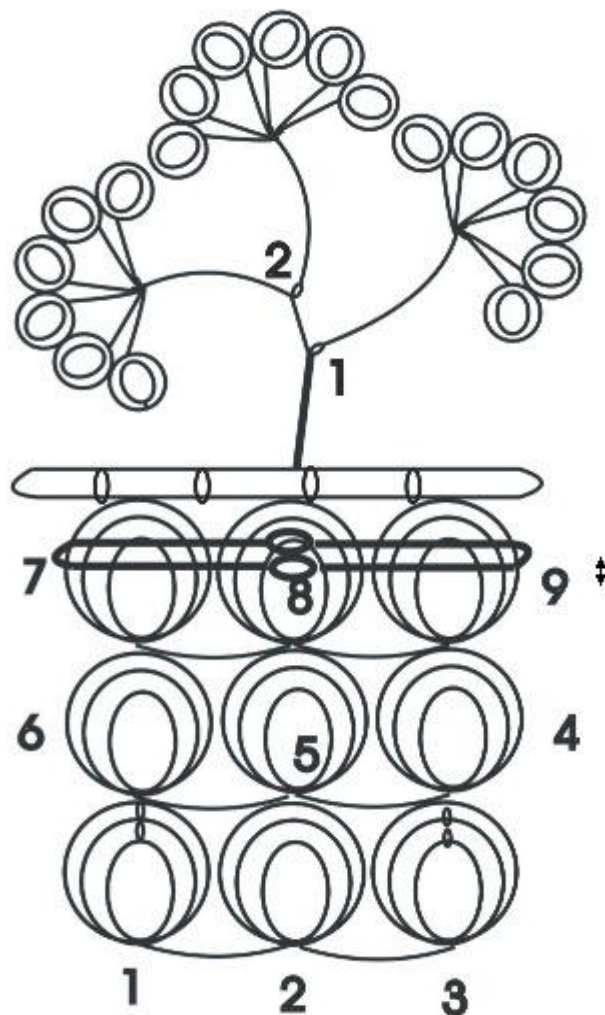


Shamrocks in a Vase inspired by a quilling pattern.

ABBREVIATIONS

R: ring

Ch: chain

SP: Split ring
- picot

+ : join

DS: double stitch

Cl: close

VSP: very small picot

CTM thread

Down picot

VASE

R1 = 4DS – 4DS. Cl.

Ch = 8DS(+) - 8DS. Cl.

Ch = 14DS(+) - 14DS. Cl.

Ch = 10DS

R3 = 4DS – 4DS. Cl.

Ch = 8DS(+) - 8DS. Cl.

SR 3 = 18DS/18DS. Cl.

R2, R4, R5, R7 R8 are equal to R1.

R6 and R9 are equal to R3.

MOUTH VASE

Ch = Make as many points as necessary to surround the mouth of the vase. Make the picot as needed. Cut and tie.

BRACE YELLOW

R = 3DS- 3DS. Cl.

Ch = 30DS

SR = 3DS/3DS. Cl.

Ch = 15DS + R. Cut and tie.

FLOWERS

1^o flower

Ch = 15 DS (double) vsp 5 DS vsp 15 DS – (picot inverted) 6 DS.

R1 = 3DS – 3DS. Cl.

Ch = 6DS + (- R1) 6DS. Cl.

R2 = 3DS – 3DS. Cl.

Ch = 6DS + (-R2) 6DS. Cl.

Ch = 6DS + down picot.

Repeated twice to form a flower. Cut and tie.

2^o and 3^o flower

Ch = CTM in 1^o picot 15 DS - (down picot). Make the flower.

Ch = CTM in 2^o picot 18 DS - (down picot). Make the flower.
