

Dangling Coral Ear Ring

Aurora Lozada April 2015

You will need:

31 small beads

1 coral bead

2 shuttles or shuttle and ball

Picot gauge 30mm or 1.18in heigh

A piece of folded wire 0.4mm or crochet hook

Thread used Anchor Frecia N.12

Thread 1 on shuttle: 1mt 70cm or 1yd 2ft 7in

19 small and coral beads

Thread 2 shuttle or ball: 1mt 44cm or 1yd 1ft 9in

12 small beads

Use CTM and add 30 cm or 1 feet

Dimensions: 5x5 cm or 2x2 in



Start pattern with thread 1 and place the 19 small beads and the coral bead as shown on photo, inside of the ring's loop.

Ch= 8DS 3BE 8DS RW # place 3 small beads

R= 10DS BE +R 10DS CR RW # Join to previous ring's very long picot

}

Ch= 18DS <RTOC= 20DS vsp 6DS CR>

4DS +R +R 4DS +RTOC 18DS CTH

join to very long picot and tie to
base of ring
