ABBREVIATIONS

DS = double stitch

R = ring

SR = split ring

Ch = chain

Cl = cluny

+ = join

- = picot

Clr = close ring

CTM = continuous thread method

2 shuttles

Thread – Lizbeth n° 80

ROUND 1

R1 = 9DS – 3DS. Clr

R2 = 3DS + (R1) 6DS – 3DS. Clr

R3 = 3DS +(R2) 9DS. Clr

Ch1 = 15DS + (- R3/R2)

Ch2 = 10DS +(- R2/R1)

Ch3 = 15DS + (Base R1)

Ch4 = 4DS - 4DS – 4DS – 4DS + (- R1/R2)

Ch5 = 4DS – 4DS – 4DS + (- R2/R3)

Ch6 = 4DS – 4DS – 4DS + (Base R3)

Ch7 = 15DS

R4 = 3DS – 3DS + (3º - Ch6) 3DS – 3DS. Clr

R5 = 3DS + (R5) 3DS – 3DS – 3DS. Clr

R6 = 3DS + (R5) 3DS – 3DS – 3DS. Clr

Ch8 = 18DS – 18DS + (R4/R5/R6)

Ch9 = 15DS

Repeat 4x by joining in the center.

LANYARD

R1 = (shuttle 1) = 4DS + (- medallion) 4DS – 4DS – 4DS. Clr

R2 = (Shuttle 2) = 4DS + (- medallion) 4DS – 4DS – 4DS. Clr

SR3 = (Shuttle ½) = 4DS + (- R1) 4DS/4DS + (R2) 4DS. Clr

Cl1 = 17 passes



Do both sides to the desired length.

The finish may be with fasteners to glue, or with a bead and beads as in the sample to tie at the desired height.
