Coats and Clark Book 121 . Pattern A-295

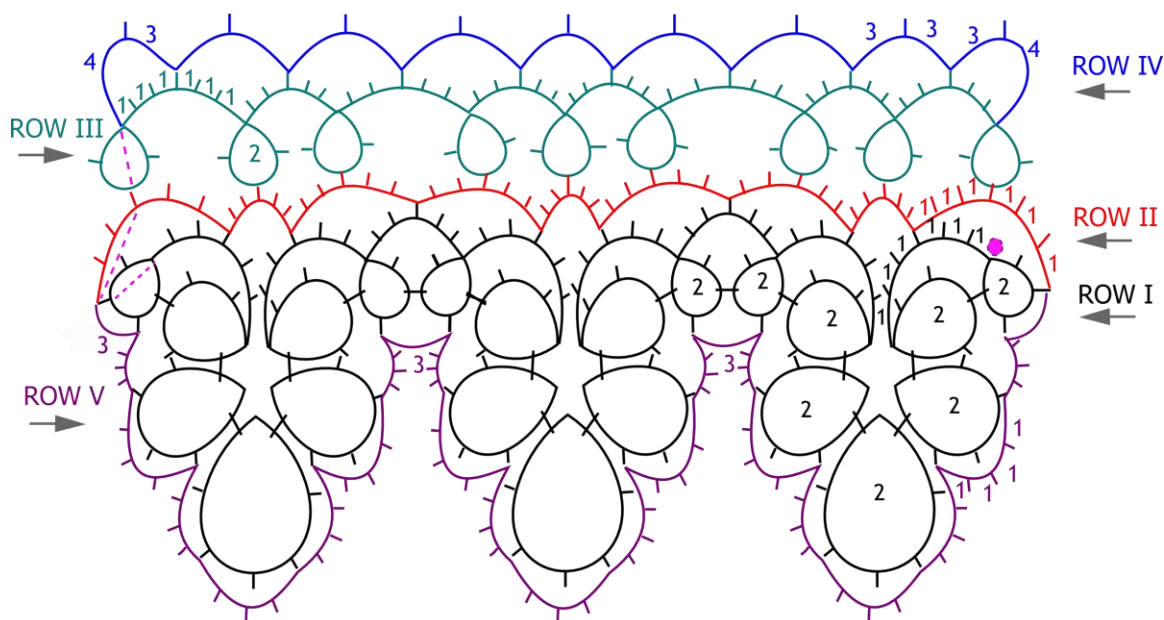

This diagram is in response to questions on how to work All 5 rows in one pass,

sequence of working in one pass :
Row I → Row V → Row II → Row III → Row I
rows are colour-coded only for differentiation
Only 3 repeats drawn (not to scale)



Throughout the pattern
2ds between each picot for rings
1ds between each picot for chains
(except in Rows IV & V)

- start pattern with ring in Row I
- ➡ direction of working the row
- ↔ split ring or split chain to climb to next row, when working all 5 rows in one pass
