

## Heart for Kay

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*You will need about 4 yards of thread and two shuttles*

This quick and easy to tat ornament is also a helpful technical/practice piece.

The short pattern includes:

- 6 rings, 1 of them is floating ring, and 6 chains;
- 3 picot types: decorative, very small, and medium size;
- 4 types of join: 2 regular joins; 4 lock (shuttle) joins;
- 1 swirl join; 1 last to first join.

*Symbols & abbreviations used in the pattern:*

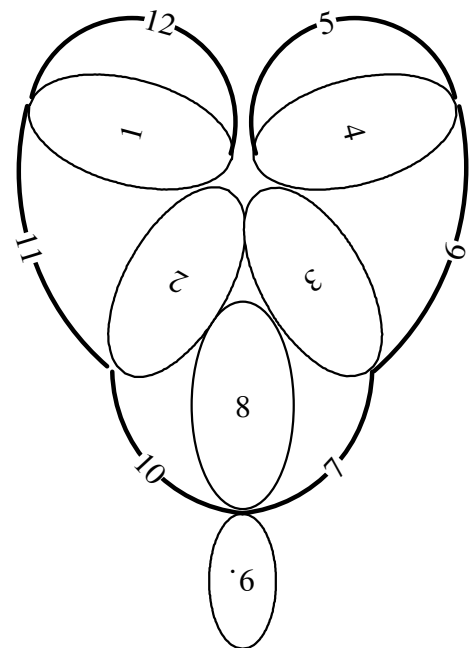
- 1, 2, 3** number of double knots;
- R** ring;
- FR** floating ring;
- CH** chain
- picot;
- + regular join (join with knotting thread);
- LJ** lock join (join with shuttle thread);
- ⊕ \*** *SWIRL* join  
(join a few rings at the same time);
- shape, tighten, and close a ring;
- RW** reverse work.



*Pattern:*

- 1) R: 3 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 4 - 9 - 3.
- 2) R: 3 + (to R1) 7 - 5 - \* 5.
- 3) R: 5 - \* 5 - 7 - 3.
- 4) R: 3 + (to R3) 9 - 4 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 3.**RW**
- 5) CH: 3 - 4 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2.**LJ** to R4
- 6) CH: 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2.**LJ** to R3
- 7) CH: 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2.**RW**
- 8) R: 10 ⊕ (to R2 and R3) 10.**RW**
- 9) FR: 7 - 7.
- 10) CH: 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2.**LJ** to R2
- 11) CH: 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2.**LJ** to R1
- 12) CH: 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 4 +\*\* (to CH5) 3.

Tie and hide the tails.



\* please keep in mind that for *SWIRL* join you need medium size picots.

\*\* last to first join
