

Snowdrift Snowflake

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Abbreviations:

R = ring

Sr = split ring

C= chain

HS = half stitch only

L J = lock join

vsp = very small picot

CTM = continuous thread method

dnrw - do not reverse work

TOR = thrown off ring (off a chain)

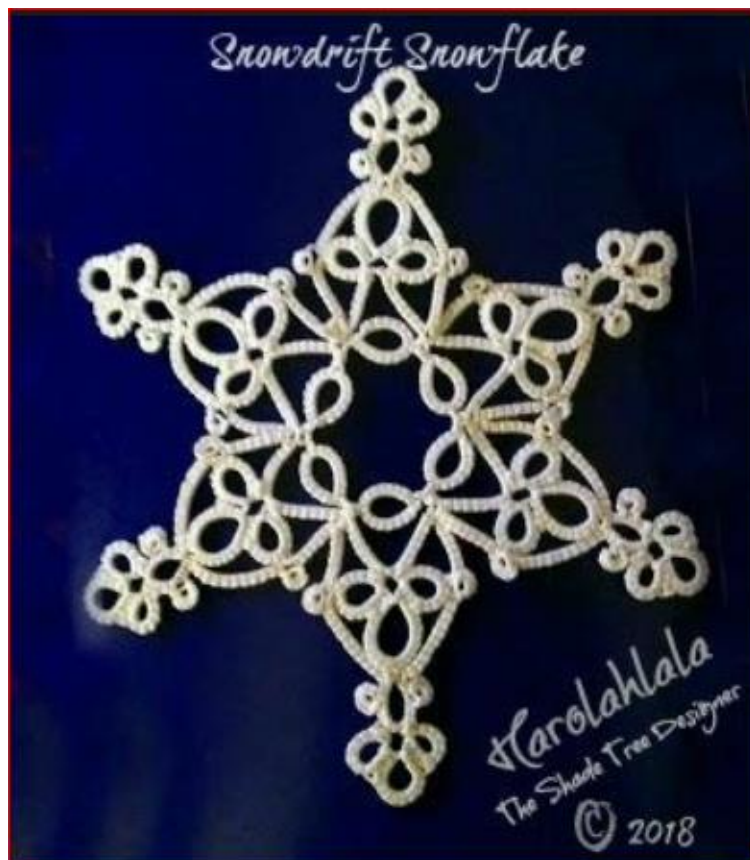
(- or +) = either a picot or a join

Clover = set pattern of three rings

* = repeat

SS = switch shuttles

JR = Josephine ring knot/chain



Materials:

2 shuttles needed, CTM

Thread of choice

Round 1: Center

SR 8/vsp 8 cl ss

C *1-1 ss

SR 8/8 cl

Repeat *for total of 6 rings, ending with C 1-1, + to first ring, then + to prev picot.

Round 2:

C7 vsp 1 ss

Clover

1+ (prev vsp) 5-5 vsp 3 cl

3+ (prev vsp) 8-8 vsp 3 cl

3+ (prev vsp) 5-5 vsp 1 ss

C 1+(prev vsp) 7 + (next picot)

Repeat around to starting point and join to base of first chain



Round 3:

C** 7 + (next picot) ss JR (2nd HS x 7) cl ss C 10 +
(next picot)

C2 ss JR (2nd HS x9) cl ss C 2 vsp 1 ss

Clover

1+ (prev vsp) 6 vsp 3 CL

3+ (prev vsp) 8 vsp 3 CL

3+ (prev vsp) 6 vsp 1 CL ss

C1 + (prev vsp) 2 ss JR (2nd HS x9) cl ss C 2 + (same
picot of current working ring of rd 2 clover) ss

C 10 + (next vsp) ss JR (2nd HS x 7) cl ss C 7 +
(same picot between rings)

repeat from ** to starting point and join, cut and tie.
