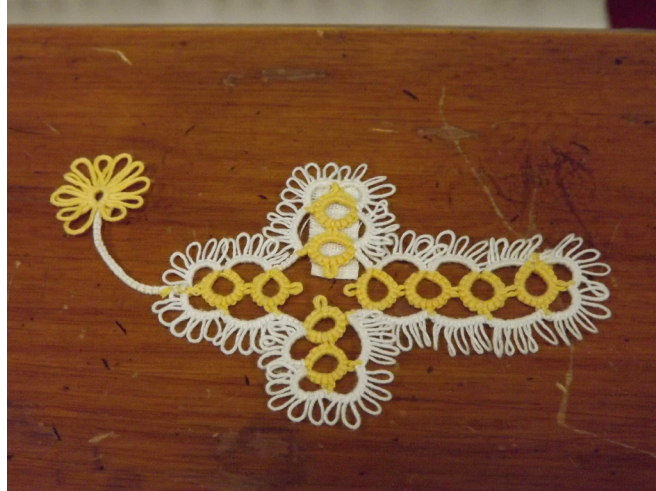


***A Simple Cross Tatted by a Benedictine Sister
at the Monastery of St. Gertrude, Cottonwood, Idaho.***



Simple cross bookmark pattern:

*The Tassel ring has 12 picots separated by 1 ds clr. rw
CH length desired rw
This rw changes the direction of the chain.*

*All the following chains have 5 picots separated by 2 ds rw except for the inner arms
with a plain 4 ds chain at the elbows.*

*R 4 + (join to the beginning of the previous chain) 4 - 4 - 4 clr rw
CH 5 picots separated by 2 ds rw
R 4 + (join to previous ring) 4 - 4 - 4 clr rw
Repeat down the arms and join the center picots across as shown.*

*If you make two long picots on ring 2 and ring 3, they can join across the open space
later to form a cross as well. Ring 2 long picot is longer than the ring 3 long picot.*

This pattern is an excellent exercise in the use of a picot gauge.
