Row 1 is a line of half-closed rings.  
R 3 - 3 half closed  
R 6 half closed  
Repeat from length desired

Row 2

Attach thread to a picot of row 1 and  
chain across

CH 8 - 8 + (join to next half-closed ring with a picot) 8 - 8 +  
(join to next half-closed ring with a picot)  
CH 6 - 4 - 6 (join to next half-closed ring with a picot)  
Repeat for length needed

Row 3

Attach thread to same picot to which row 2 was attached

CH 10 - 5 rw

(Work rings in reverse half stitch order if you want the all  
front side up look)

R 5 - 5 + (join to picot of row 2) 5 - 5 clr rw

CH 5 - 5 dnrw

Using SH2 floating ring

R 3 - 4 - 4 - 3 clr dnrw

CH 5 - 5 rw

R 5 - 5 + (join next picot of row 2) 5 - 5 clr rw

CH 5 - 10

CH 6 + (join next picot of row 2) 4 - 4 + (join next picot of row 2) 6

Repeat for length needed

Row 4

Attach thread to picot on first chain of  
row 3

CH 8 - 8 + (join to picot of floating ring)

CH 6 - 6 - 6 - 6 + (join to picot of floating  
ring)

CH 8 - 8 + (join to picot of row 3 chain)

CH 6 + (join to picot of row 3 chain) dnrw

Using SH2 floating ring

R 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 clr dnrw

CH 6 +

Repeat for length needed

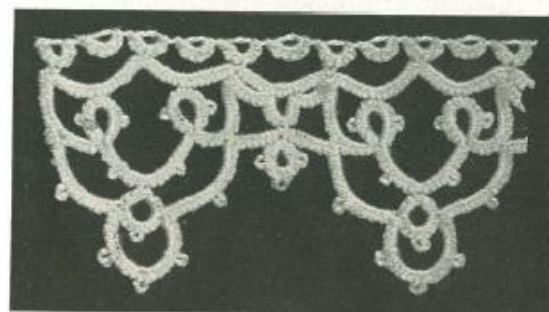
