SKFuller...: WELCOME TO THE MONDAY TATTING CLASS

Sheepmeister: My issue is following graphs. I always want to go counterclockwise.

SKFuller...: IS THERE ANOTHER NAME YOU

SKFuller...: IS THERE ANOTHER NAME YOU LIKE US TO USE HERE SHEEPMEISTRER?

Sheepmeister: Mary

SKFuller...: WONDERFUL

SKFuller...: BETTER ANSWERED IN A LATER PART OF THE LESSON, BUT USUALLY SOMEONE ELSE OFTEN WILL.

mssandrafigg: sheepmeister, the thing about graphs is they lie a little about the direction when you casually look at them. For instance if you are doing chains, you did a rw to do the chains, which means you are on the back of the doily and how you are working is toward the right, but the GRAPH did not turn over, so it would seem that you are moving to the left, according to the diagram. You might have to mull that over.

SKFuller...: OOPS, QUESTIONS CAN BE ASKED DURING CLASS. I MAY NOT ANSWER RIGHT AWAY, SO I MAY TYPE "LATER" IF IT IS BETTER ANSWERED IN A LATER PART OF THE LESSON, BUT USUALLY SOMEONE ELSE OFTEN WILL.

SKFuller...: HAVE ANY OF YOU NOT TATTED A SCMR (SELF CLOSING MOCK RING) OR A THROWN RING?

sandrafiggOHIO: I really love the white snowflake wheel! is there directions for that version?

SKFuller...: I'M NOT SURE, WILL HAVE TO ASK MUSKAAN

Aurora: tatting that snowflake with ROR will be a lot of fun.

sandrafiggOHIO: what is ROR?

SKFuller...: THE OVERALL PATH IS: STARTS WITH 2 SHUTTLE WITH CMT - CONTINUOUS THREAD METHOD

SKFuller...: THE SAFTEY PIN AT THE BEGINNING IS A TYPE THAT IS COILESS AND THIS PARTICULAR ONE IS A JEWELRY BAIL TYPE THATA CAN BE FOUND ON AMAZON

SKFuller...: I FORGOT ROR, IS IT REVERSE ORDER ,, AURORA?

Cyn: I think Ring ON Ring another way of saying Thrown Ring on a ring

sandrafiggOHIO: OK

SKFuller...: OR I OFTEN BY SUPPLIES AT FIRE MOUNTAIN GEMS <https://www.firemountaingems.com/search?...>

SKFuller...: THANKS CYN

Cyn: yw

SKFuller...: REGULAR COILESS SAFTEY PINS CAN BE USED AND CAN BE FOUND A CRAFT AND QUILTING/SEWING STORES

SKFuller...: I LIKE THESE BAIL STYLE BECAUSE OF THEIR SIZE, SHAPE AND THAT THE CLOSURE PART IS SIMPLER SO THREAD DOES NOT GAET TANGLED IN IT

Cyn: or a paperclip and even a safety pin but you gotta be very careful where the loop is on them

SKFuller...: YES THANKS CYN

SKFuller...: THE NEXT PART IS A MOCK JOSEPHINE RING BUT JUST A BIT DIFFERENT THAN USUAL

Bernice: I have used leverback earrings too.

Aurora: Sorry my kb didnt work, ROR is Ring thrown Off Ring

SKFuller...: ANYONE NOT DONE A MOCK RING BEFORE?

Aurora: had to placed it

SKFuller...: I'VE USED THOSE TOO BERNICE 😊

Bernice: 👍

Aurora: and this one is not working well eiaer

SKFuller...: IF YOU NEED A REFRESHER GO TO THE OPEN VIDEO WINDOW OR OPEN <https://www.youtube.com/channel/UC4BMgfa...>

SKFuller...: SELECT: CHOOSE: Lesson 20 Self Closing Mock Ring in Shuttle Tattng or SCMR

SKFuller...: OOPS, FIRST CLICK ON THE MAGNIFIER IN UPPER RIGH CORNER AND TYPE MOCK RING

SKFuller...: REMEMBER TO MAKE THE BEGINNING LOOP FOR A MOCK RING THEN

SKFuller...: MAKE THE JOSEPHINE 6 STITCHES

SKFuller...: I USED THE FIRST DS HALF STITCH BOTH BECAUSE IT WILL BE EASIER TO REMEMBER WHICH HALF TO USE LATER AND BECAUSE THE FIRST HALF WILL TWIST FORWARD TO THE INSIDE AND I LIKE THE LOOK OF THAT

SKFuller...: IT WILL MAKE IT LOOK NICELY TAPERED DOWN AND INWARD GOING UP TO THE THROWN RING.

SKFuller...: THE SS - SWITCH SHUTTLES. LEAVE A SMALL LENGTH OF BARE THREAD TO BECOME THE LEFT SIDE OF A MOCK PICOT

sandrafiggOHIO: WAIT... are people doing this as we sit here? I had no idea. No one said to get shuttles ready to begin. I thought it was just discussion and you did it afterward. ?

Cyn: that is correct...Sue is going over the pattern so if you have a question it gets answered now

Cyn: wb Sue

sandrafiggOHIO: which is correct? that they are doing it now ~or~ later?

Bernice: later

SKFuller1: Some tatters bring shuttles & work while we discuss the pattern but many do not

Bernice: I usually tat but today I am knitting 😊

SKFuller1: After today I will be giving out the pattern for the next class much earlier so many tatters will work on it before class

SKFuller1: It's just personal preference

SKFuller1: And next week we will have a question and answer time about this pattern before we begin a new lesson

SKFuller1: DOES THIS MAKE SENSE TO EVERYONE

Sheepmeister: Yes

SKFuller1: THAT THIS TIME THE MOCK JOSEPHINE RING IS NOT CLOSED, THE THROWN RING IS MADE FIRST.. SO CONTINUE KEEPING THE BEGINNING LOOP ON YOUR FINGER FOR THE JR MOCK RING

SKFuller1: AS YOU ARE TATTING THE THROWN RING

SKFuller1: THEN CLOSE THE THROWN RING, SS AND LEAVING A BARE SPACE EQUAL TO THE FIRST BARE THREAD SPACE

SKFuller1: THIS CREATES THE SECOND SIDE OF THE MOCK PICOT

SKFuller1: AND MAKE 6 HALF STITCHES - I USED THE SECOND HALF OF A DS FOR THIS SO IT MIRRORS THE FIRST HALF OF THE JOSEPHINE RING

Lottiefla: Makes sense to me

SKFuller1: GREAT

SKFuller1: ANY QUESTSION OR COMMENTS ABOUT THIS PATTERN BEFORE WE GO ON?

Cyn: makes sense to me.

SKFuller1: NOW USE THE SAVED BEGINNING LOOP TO CLOSE THE MOCK JOSEPHINE RING

Cyn: I need to run we have an errand that really can't wait. I'll be back tonight,

SKFuller1: OK BYE CYN

Cyn: bye for now

SKFuller1: THE NEXT SHORT SECTION IS DONE WITH 3 RS - REVERSE STITCHS

SKFuller1: THIS IS LIKE WRAPPING A DS IN THE SECOND HALF OF A SPLIT RING.

SKFuller1: THEY ARE UNFLIPPED DS WHICH MAKE A CHAIN WITH THE DS FACING DOWNWARDS

SKFuller1: HOWEVER WHEN DOING THIS YOU BEGIN WITH THE SECOND HALF OF A DS, THEN DO THE FIRST

SKFuller1: SO YOU ARE REVERSING THE ORDER OF THE LEGS

SKFuller1: THIS GIVE YOU 3 COMPLETE LOOKING DS ON THIS FRONT SIDE OF THE WORK

SKFuller1: IT REPLACES HAVING TO RW - REVERSE WORK TO MAKE JUST THE 3 DS CHAIN

SKFuller1: YOU ACTUALLY COULD RW THE WORK, MAKE 3 DS, THEN REVERSE THE WORK FOR THE NEXT RING.

SKFuller1: THIS IS FRONTSIDE/BACKSIDE TATTING WHICH SOME TATTERS USE ALL THE TIME FOR CHAINS TO ELIMINATE THE NEED TO RW MOST OF THE TIME

SKFuller1: AND CAN MAKE TATTING GO FASTER

SKFuller1: THIS TECHNIQUE IS ALSO CALLED DIRECTIONAL TATTING

Bernice: I really like using it when there are only a few chain stitches between rings

SKFuller1: HMMMM, MY SAMPLE STOPPED AT THIS POINT AND I JUST REALIZED THAT THE NEXT STEP WOULD BE TO RW FOR A REGULAR JOSEPHINE RING THAT JOINS TO THE MOCK PICOT SO

Bernice: Sorry Susan, time for me to get on with my Monday chores. Thanks for the lesson, bye all.

SKFuller1: IT SEEMS TO ME IT WOULD BE JUST AS EASY TO RW FOR THOSE LAST 3 DS AND THEN SS FOR THE JOSEPHINE RING

SKFuller1: THE REST OF THE ARM OF THIS SNOWFLAKE IS QUITE STRAIGHT FORWARD SO THIS IS WHERE TODAY'S LESSON WILL END

Lottiefla: Thank you.

SKFuller1: THE REST OF THE SNOWFLAKE ARMS ARE JUST REPEATS OF THIS FIRST ONE WITH A JOIN TO THE FIRST PICOT OF THE FIRST ARM

Sheepmeister: Thanks

SKFuller1: YOU'RE WELCOME

SKFuller1: HOPE YOU'VE ENJOYED THIS AND WILL COME TO CLASS AGAIN!

SKFuller1: ANY SUGGESTIONS FOR PATTERNS OR A BETTER LESSON ARE WELCOMED

SKFuller1: BYE FOR NOW AND BEST WISHES

SECOND SESSION

SKFuller...: Hi Mary

SKFuller...: brb, need to check email

SKFuller...: Just a minute more while I sent a tatter the indo to get here!

SKFuller...: Sorry I'm back now

Rebecca: Hi Susan!

SKFuller...: Hi Rebecca

SKFuller...: Welcome

Rebecca: Do I need anything for this class?

Rebecca: Thanks

SKFuller...: No. Some tatters like to have their supplies to work the pattern as we go but most don't

Rebecca: ok what pattern are we working on tonight? Is it something I can print out? Sorry for so many questions!

Cyn: Just not sure which class everyone is looking for. I remember starting in this class and being soooooo lost....

SKFuller...: JUST LIKE A REGULAR MOCK RING BUT ONLY STARTING WITH 6 HALF STITCHES

Rebecca: does it matter if 1st or 2nd half of double stitch?

SKFuller...: I LIKE TO DO THIS FIRST JK WITH THE FIRST HALF OF A DS BECAUSE BECAUSE OF THE WAY IT TILTS INWARD AS YOU TAT IT

Rebecca: ok

SKFuller...: WHICH I THINK GIVE A NICE TAPERED LOOK BEFORE THE THROWN RING WHICH IS NEXT

SKFuller...: THE FIRST HALF STS WILL TIP TOWARD YOU SO THE TWIST IS TO THE RIGHT

SKFuller...: DARN, I FORGOT TO ASK WHO DOESN'T KNOW HOW TO MAKE A MOCK RING?

Jeanne: All good here on mock rings.

Cyn: I can do them

Jon: I am good with mock rings.

Rebecca: got it

SKFuller...: GREAT

SKFuller...: NOW THE FIRST HALF OF THE MOCK JOSEPHINE RING (JK) IS MADE AND NOW

SKFuller...: WE DO NOT CLOSE IT

SKFuller...: NEED TO KEEP THE BEGINNING LOOP TO USE FOR CLOSING LATER. IT SHOULD JUST HANG DOWN IF YOU DON'T HAVE IT AROUND A FINGER

Cyn: Did everyone sign in? WE SIGN IN EVERY CLASS TO GET TO KNOW EACH OTHER BETTER. MEMBERS USUALLY ADD THEIR NAMES, LOCATION, AND EMAIL ADDRESSES, TATTING EXPERIENCE & IF SHUTTLE OR NEEDLE.

SKFuller...: I DID FORGET TO REMIND YOU ALL ABOUT NEEDING THAT STARTING RING FOR THE MOCK JK

SKFuller...: NOW SS AND MAKE THE THROWN RING (ROR - RING OFF A RING)

SKFuller...: OOPS BUT LEAVE A BARE THREAD SPACE BEFORE THE ROR AS IT WILL MAKE A MOCK PICOT LATER

SKFuller...: HAVE I GOTTEN TOO CONFUSING?

Jeanne: Not for me, I'm still with you.

Jon: You can also place another safety pin on the shuttle thread before making the thrown ring to hold the space for the mock picot.

Cyn: still with you

SKFuller...: GOOD IDEA THANKS JON

Rebecca: I'm good

SKFuller...: CLOSE THE THROWN RING

SKFuller...: THE NEXT LITTLE CH CAN BE DOWN 2 WAYS

SKFuller...: YOU COULD REVERSE YOU WORK, SS, TAT 3 DS THEN

Jon: Sue, did you miss explaining the second part of the JK?

SKFuller...: DARN AGAIN, BEFORE THIS LITTLE CH LEAVE A BARE THREAD SPACE TO MATCH THE FIRST ONE SO A COMPLETE MOCK PICOT IS MADE

SKFuller...: YES, GUESS I'M GETTING TIRED, THANKS JON

SKFuller...: AFTER THE FALSE PICOT YOU NEED TO TAT THE 2ND HALF OF THE MOCK JK. I USED THE SECOND HALF OF A DS TO MIRROR THE FIRST JK SIDE

SKFuller...: SLIDE THE SHUTTLE THROUGH THE SAVED STARTING LOOP TO CLOSE THE JK

SKFuller...: NOW THAT SHORT CH OF 3 DS

Jon: Yes!. I was wondering of you plan to continue with making the 1st half or changing to making the 2nd half, because i was thingking of doing the 2nd half too.

SKFuller...: YES, IT REALLY MAKE A NICE SHAPE AT THE BASE OF THE THROWN RING

Cyn: now it is making more sense to me!

Rebecca: Thanks Sue! I need to head out.

Rebecca: Have a good night all

SKFuller...: OK WE ARE ALMOST DONE BECAUSE THE REST IS STRAIGHT FORWARD TO FINISH THE SNOWFLAKE ARE

SKFuller...: THEN JUST REPEAT FOR THE OTHER 5 ARMS

Cyn: That is an awesome snowflake

SKFuller...: THE ONLY OTHER THING I WANTED TO MENTION IS THAT INSTEAD OF RW WORK TWICE - MUSKAAN HAS DONE THE SHORT CH OF 3 WITH REV STS

SKFuller...: THESE ARE UNFLIPPED STITCHES AND YOU DO THE LEGS IN REVERSE ORDER

Jeanne: I'm going to try the reverse stitches for the short chain too. It seems quicker.

Jon: Doing the reverse stitches is a good step.

SKFuller...: YES IT IS AND LESS FUSSY

SKFuller...: THEN JUST CONTINUE THE PATTERN

SKFuller...: DOING THE LEGS WITH A 2ND HALF DS THEN A FIRST HALF DS MAKES WHOLE DS ON THE FRONT SIDE OF THE WORK

Jon: It is a pretty snowflake motif. Joining up several together may make a nice mat/doily too, I think.

SKFuller...: SOME TATTERS USE THIS METHOD CALLED DIRECTIONAL TATTING OR FRONTSIDE/BACKSIDE TATTING

SKFuller...: MOST OF THE TIME ON ALL PATTERNS

SKFuller...: I LIKE THE IDEA OF A MAT - THANKS

SKFuller...: WELL THAT'S IT FOR TONIGHT

SKFuller...: QUESTIONS OR COMMENTS?

Jeanne: Thank you Sue. Good night all.

Cyn: Thank you Sue for an awesome class
